### Tel Aviv U. Recruits a Record Number of Returning Israeli Scholars

Tel Aviv University has managed to recruit a record 50 Israeli scholars returning from abroad this year as part of a drive to attract younger staff members and reverse a national "brain drain."

"It reflects TAU's concerted drive to recruit the very best young scientists and scholars—many of whom are returning to Israel from top institutions in the U.S.A. and elsewhere," says Mr. Klafter.

In 2003, Tel Aviv University had 1,470 professors and senior lecturers, but a budget crisis at the university, combined with deep cuts in government financing, forced the institution to reduce the number of faculty members by more than 30 percent and cap it at 970. Similar staff reductions hit Israel's other publicly supported research universities.

The result was a huge "brain drain" of scholars, mainly to the United States. Some 25 percent of Israeli academics are now believed to be employed abroad, based on a 2008 Tel Aviv University study using data from the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development.

"This is the highest percentage in the world," says Manuel Trajtenberg, chairman of the Planning and Budgeting Committee of the Council for Higher Education, which oversees Israeli colleges.

"There is no other country in the world where a quarter of its scientists have left to work somewhere else. Canada is in second place with 12 percent."

The Israeli government this year approved a \$300-million plan to help create positions at universities for returning academics to fill.

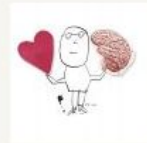
